The thing is — and what few people seem to understand — prints come in all shapes and sizes with myriad patterns, designs and colours. There is definitely something for everyone.

When trying to pick a print that is right for you, go with your instincts and comfort level. And you must also be aware that there is a fine line between prints that are groovy and prints that can look totally wrong. Pick

the wrong print and you can wind up looking mumsy, or worse, tacky! Here are some tips that might help

you find your perfect print: The size of the prints should flatter your physique. If you are large, tall or big-boned, opt for larger prints to suit your igure. However, if you're petite, large prints will simply overwhelm your body type. Look for smaller patterns

in softer shades to

complement your

shape.

Secondly, the right colour combination is crucial when wearing prints. Avoid odd or clashing shades that are less-than-pleasing on the eye. Stick to a neutral colour scheme or light washes of colour if you're unsure.

Thirdly, and

perhaps most importantly, when choosing an item of clothing with prints, make sure the fit, cut and construction of the outfit is current. Slightly more boho

is current. Slightly more bohoinspired, flowing shapes are back for Spring/Summer, for example, so do try a peasant top with a simple print.

Alt is possible to glam up your look when wearing prints by accessorising with a chunky oversized choker or layers of chain necklaces, as prints tend to go well with metallics like gold, silver or

bronze. Experiment with metallic shoes, handbags, cuffs and bangles for a more outstanding look.
