ei Ling. You have to understand that every figure has its flaws. Thankfully, there are always ways to hide imperfections. Here are some tips that will help.

- Empire-cut dresses give the illusion of a false waistline. If possible, avoid outfits that have pleats or gathers around the waist as they can make you look pregnant.
- boast a deep V-neckline and flared mid-length sleeves these will distract attention from the waistline.
- Loosely structured dresses with vertical patterns or details, such as stripes and vertical trimmings, visually elongate your torso, thereby making you look slimmer. Centrally positioned prints and embellishments also help to draw eyes inward making your body look narrower. Stiffer fabrics skim the

body and streamline curves, making you

look slimmer. Flashing a bit of skin around the neckline helps as well.

- Dress up the neck area. with lavers of stunning long necklaces so that people will focus more on your face and upper body.
